CONSTRUCTION CHECKLIST

WALLS

- Paint Finish: Check for even coverage and no missed spots.
- Cracks or Holes: Inspect for any cracks, holes, or uneven surfaces.
- Nail Pops: Ensure no nails are protruding through the paint.
- Cleanliness: Check for any marks, smudges, or dirt.

SKIRTING BOARDS

- Paint Chips: Look for any chips or scuffs in the paint.
- Alignment: Ensure skirting boards are aligned properly with the floor.
- Gaps: Check for gaps between the skirting boards and the walls.

FLOORS

- Even Surface: Inspect for any uneven areas or bumps.
- Installation Quality: Ensure floorboards, tiles, or carpet are installed properly without gaps.
- Scratches or Damage: Check for any scratches, dents, or damages.

DOORS

- Operation: Make sure all doors open and close smoothly without sticking.
- Alignment: Check that doors are properly aligned and latch correctly.
- Finish: Inspect the paint or finish for any chips or imperfections.

WINDOWS

- Operation: Ensure windows open, close, and lock properly.
- Seals: Check the seals around windows for drafts or gaps.
- Cleanliness: Inspect for any paint splatters or marks on the glass

ELECTRICAL

- Outlets and Switches: Verify that all outlets and switches are installed and functioning.
- Light Fixtures: Ensure all light fixtures are properly installed and operational.
- Smoke Detectors: Confirm that smoke detectors are installed and functioning.

PLUMBING

- Fixtures: Check that sinks, faucets, and toilets are installed and
- functioning properly.
- Leaks: Inspect for any signs of leaks or water damage.
- Water Pressure: Ensure good water pressure in all faucets and showers

KITCHEN

- Cabinets and Drawers: Check for proper installation and smooth operation.
- Countertops: Inspect for any scratches, chips, or imperfections.
- Appliances: Verify that all appliances are installed and functioning properly

BATHROOM

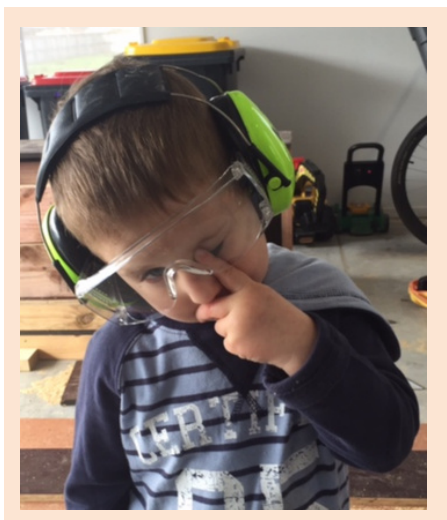
- Tiles and Grout: Ensure tiles are properly installed and grouted.
- Shower and Bath: Check for proper installation and no leaks.
- Ventilation: Ensure bathroom ventilation fans are installed and operational

EXTERIOR

- Siding and Paint: Inspect exterior siding and paint for any damage or imperfections.
- Gutters and Downspouts: Ensure gutters and downspouts are properly installed and functioning.
- Doors and Windows: Check exterior doors and windows for proper sealing and operation.

GENERAL

- Cleanliness: Ensure the entire construction site is clean and free of debris.
- Final Walkthrough: Conduct a final walkthrough with the contractor to address any remaining issues.
